

**Deer often destroy new growth and deform plants by nibbling buds, leaves, and twig-ends.**

**Some Common Deer-Resistant Trees...**

- Box Elders
- Black Locusts
- Pines
- Spruces

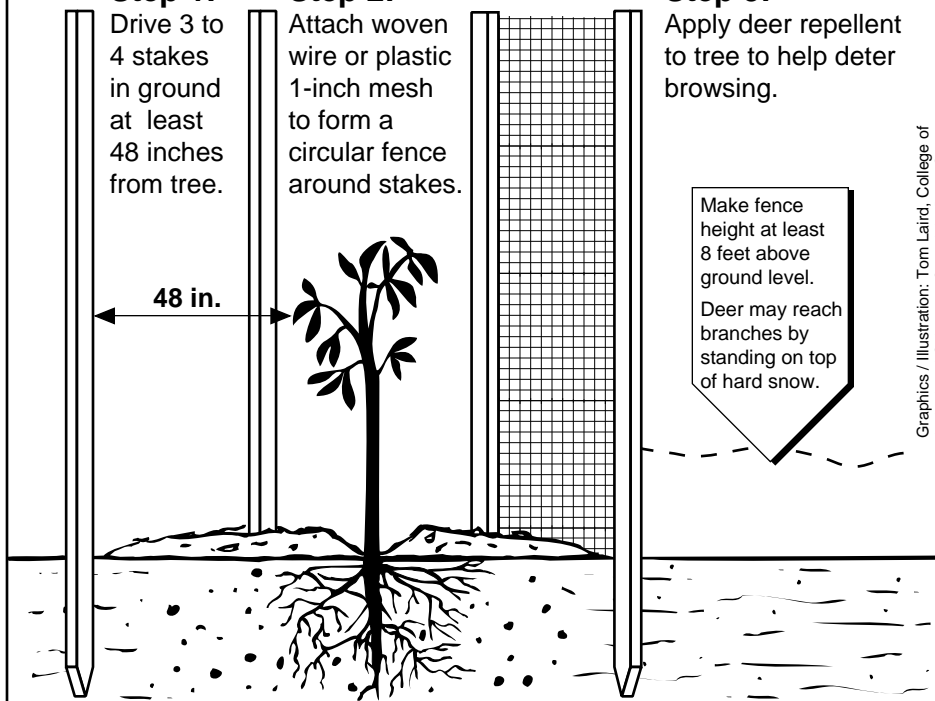
**and Shrubs...**

- Barberries
- Hollies
- Tree Peonies
- Rhododendrons
- Lilacs

**Step 1:**  
Drive 3 to 4 stakes in ground at least 48 inches from tree.

**Step 2:**  
Attach woven wire or plastic 1-inch mesh to form a circular fence around stakes.

**Step 3:**  
Apply deer repellent to tree to help deter browsing.
