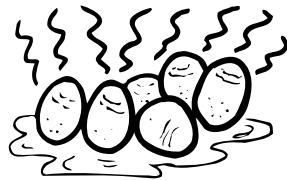


**Penn State Pointers ► Keep Shrubs Safe from Deer**

- Repellents will wash off in rain and snow.
- Repellents will not deter extremely hungry deer.
