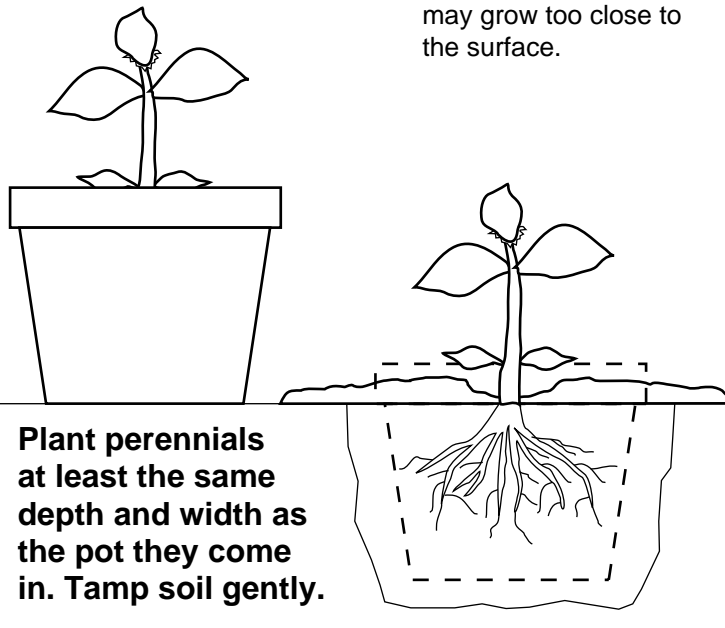


Add interest to gardens and landscapes during cold months with fall-blooming perennials.

Remember...

- Prepare soil by adding fertilizer, bone meal, and organic matter.
- Mulching deters weeds, retains soil moisture.
- Water deeply, or roots may grow too close to the surface.



Plant perennials at least the same depth and width as the pot they come in. Tamp soil gently.

Plant perennials from spring to mid-October.
