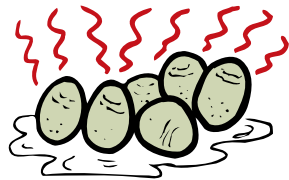


Penn State Pointers ► Keep Shrubs Safe from Deer

**HOWEVER...**

- Repellents should be used in combination with other controls such as fencing.
- Repellents will wash off in rain and snow.
- Repellents will not deter extremely hungry deer.
