

**A Fall Yard and Garden Check List:**

Completed

**Mow your grass until it stops growing.**

Tall grass gets matted under the snow, encouraging growth of snow mold.

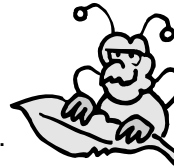


**Clear your gardens of debris and garden litter.**

Insect eggs, fungi, and plant diseases can overwinter in dead plants and leaves.

**Turn the soil in food and flower gardens.**

It helps debris decompose quickly so pests and disease cannot survive.



**Remove weeds in late autumn and early winter.**

A single weed pulled now can prevent hundreds of sprouting weeds in spring.

**Prepare trees and shrubs for winter conditions.**

Remove dead twigs and branches. Mulch around trees. Fence and wrap as needed.
