

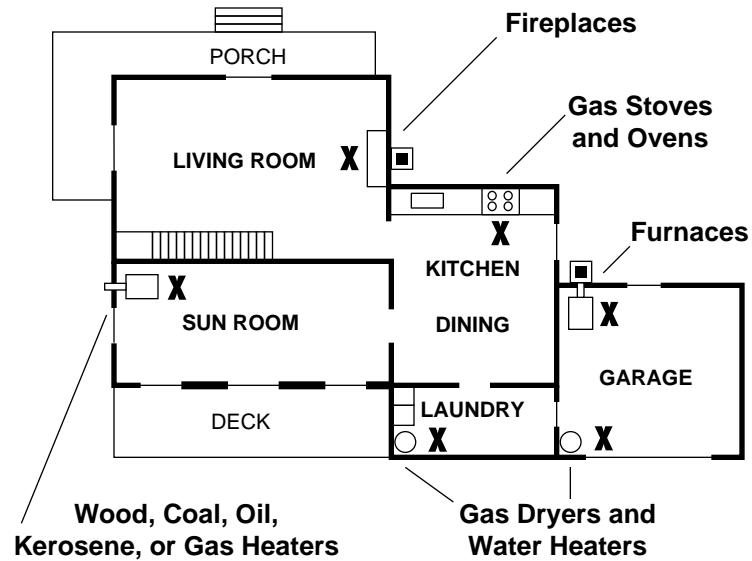
Carbon monoxide
