

**A good gasoline lawn mower should last at least ten years, if properly maintained.**

**Drain gas from the tank and  
replace engine oil before winter storage.**

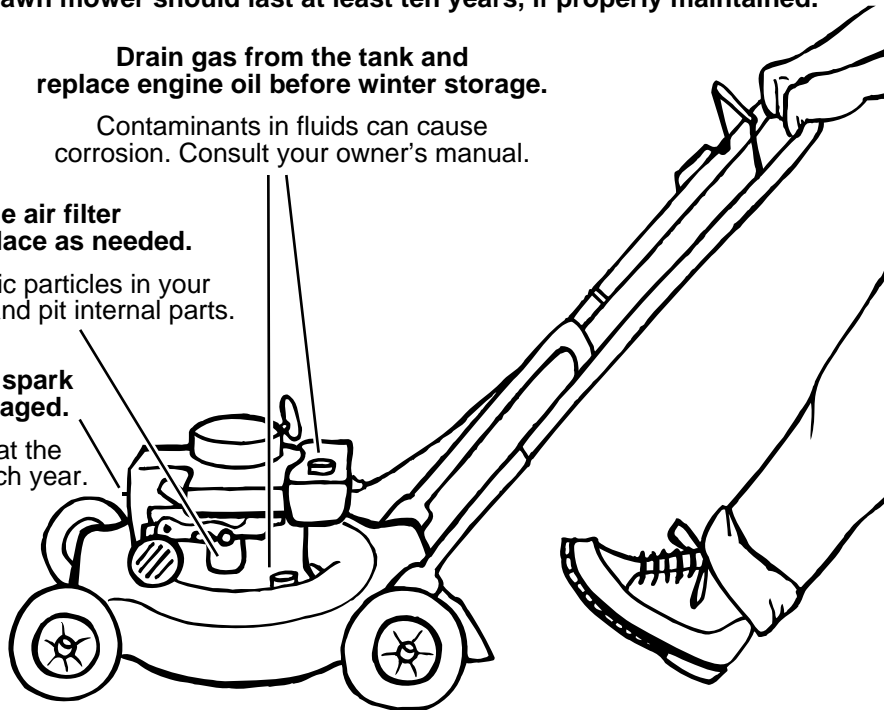
Contaminants in fluids can cause  
corrosion. Consult your owner's manual.

**Clean the air filter  
regularly; replace as needed.**

Even microscopic particles in your  
engine will wear and pit internal parts.

**Check and clean the spark  
plug; replace if damaged.**

This should be done at the  
beginning or end of each year.
