

A good gasoline lawn mower should last at least ten years, if properly maintained.

Drain gas from the tank and replace engine oil before winter storage.

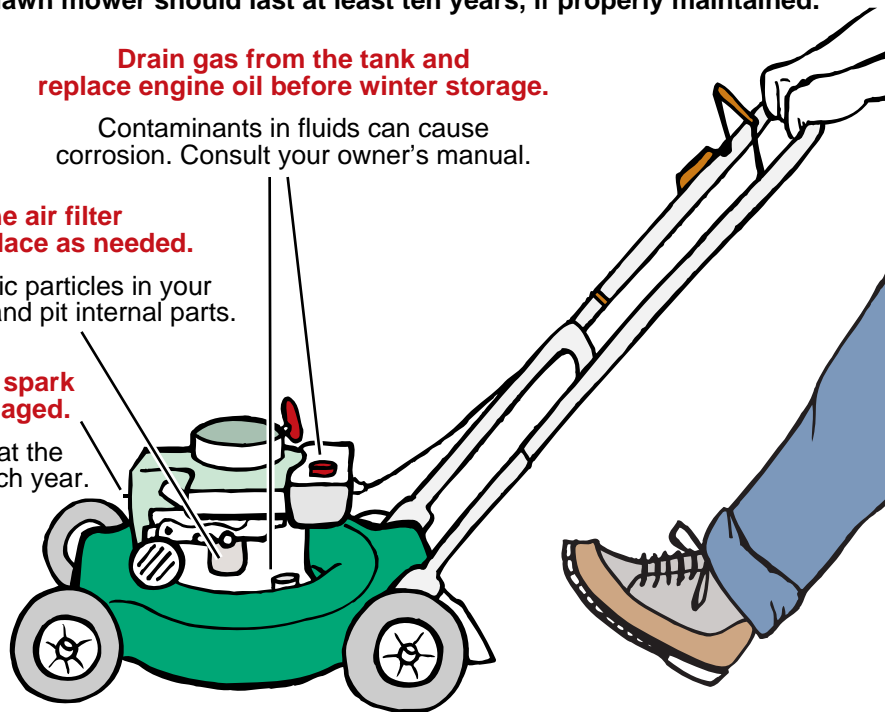
Contaminants in fluids can cause corrosion. Consult your owner's manual.

Clean the air filter regularly; replace as needed.

Even microscopic particles in your engine will wear and pit internal parts.

Check and clean the spark plug; replace if damaged.

This should be done at the beginning or end of each year.
